

Tipsheet for PSA Employees: Broward Health Go-Live on March 1st

Important Information About Your Badges

As part of the Broward Health (BH) go-live on **March 1st**, all PSA employees will be issued **two badges**. Each badge serves a specific purpose, and it is important to use them correctly to ensure smooth access and identification.

Badge Overview

1. NCHS Badge (Top Badge)

- **Purpose:** Identification purposes only.
- **Usage:** This badge will be used to identify you as an NCHS PSA Contracted employee.
- **Placement:** Always wear this badge on top of your BH badge for clear visibility.

2. BH Badge (Bottom Badge)

- **Purpose:** Access to Broward Health facilities and systems.
 - **Usage:** This badge will be required to enter BH facilities and access restricted areas.
 - **Placement:** Wear this badge directly under your NCHS badge.
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Key Guidelines for Badge Usage

- **Always Wear Both Badges Together** so that you can easily flip the badge in order to be identified while on duty
- **Proper Placement:**
 - NCHS badge should be on top.
 - BH badge should be underneath.
- **Access Control:** Use your BH badge to swipe for entry into BH facilities and restricted areas.

- **Identification:** Use your NCHS badge for identification purposes when interacting with staff, patients, or visitors.
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Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. What should I do if I lose my NCHS or BH badge?

- Report the loss immediately to your supervisor and the appropriate badge office:
 - **NCHS Badge:** Contact the NCHS badge office.
 - **BH Badge:** Contact the BH security office for a replacement.

2. Can I use my NCHS badge for access to BH facilities?

- No, the NCHS badge is for identification purposes only. You must use your BH badge for access to BH facilities.

3. What if my BH badge does not work for access?

- If your BH badge does not grant access, contact the BH security office or your supervisor for assistance.

4. Do I need to wear both badges outside of BH facilities?

- Yes, both badges should be worn at all times
